

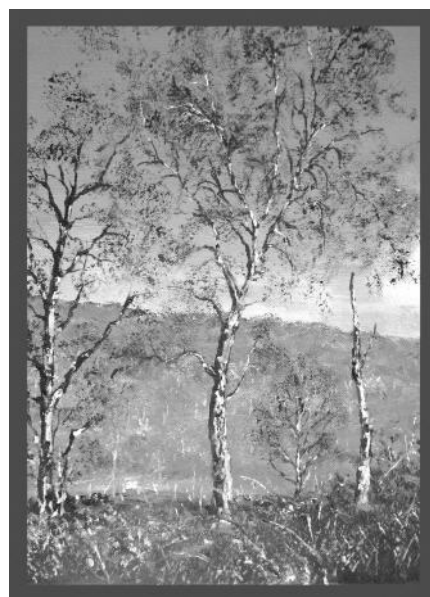

### Data Protection Act & Membership Records

In order to help make the administration of the Society's finances easier, our membership records are held on computer.

The Data Protection Act enables clubs and societies to be exempt from registration (which costs a significant amount, even for a small Society such as the DNHS) as long as two conditions are satisfied:

- 1) That all members are asked whether they object to data relating to them being held on computer by the club, and,
- 2) That data about members may only be disclosed in very limited circumstances.

Membership records are only available to the Committee, and are not passed to any other third party. Please inform me if you object to having such details held on computer, and I will ensure that they are removed.
